



FACILITIES AT NOMANSLAND RECREATION GROUND UPDATE JAN 2021

When Nomansland Sports Association (NSA) ceased to exist in June 2020, a third party 360 Degree Community Development stepped forward to take ownership of the Clubhouse, Tennis Courts, and Skate Park

We're pleased to report Sport England has endorsed 360 Degree Community Development for this transfer to go-ahead; a necessary step as Sport England entered into a Grant Award Agreement with NSA for the build (in whole or in part) of these facilities back in 2015. This Grant Award Agreement transfers to 360 Degree Community Development along with ownership of the facilities.

As Landford Parish Council owns the land upon which these facilities sit, we are in the process of drawing-up a Lease Agreement with 360 Degree Community Development. We will update members of the public once the Lease is in place.

Access to these facilities by members of the public may vary from time to time according to COVID19 social distancing measures imposed by the government.

Landford Parish Council continue to own and manage the NML Play Park. At the time of this notice the NML Play Park remains open.
